## Swiss Standard Classification of Occupations – CH-ISCO-19

Description	The CH-ISCO-19 incorporates the first four levels of the International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO-08) and has added a fifth level to take into account the particularities of the Swiss labour market. This classification replaces the Swiss Standard Classification of Occupations from 2000 (SSCO 2000).
