Goods transport in 2019

## Goods transport in Switzerland declined by 2.2% in 2019

The transport performance of goods transport fell by 2.2% in 2019 compared with the previous year. The decrease in road transport was 2.7% and in rail transport 1.4%. About a third of the volume carried by rail was transported in combined transport. These are some of the findings of the goods transport statistics produced by the Federal Statistical Office (FSO).

In 2019, transport performance on the Swiss road and rail network totalled 27.2 billion tonne-kilometres. A tonne-kilometre is the transport of one tonne over a distance of one kilometre. Compared with the previous year, this amounts to a decline of 2.2%, with goods transport by road falling somewhat more sharply (-2.7%) than goods transport by rail (-1.4%).

Rail's share in total transport performance remained unchanged in 2019 at around 37% and that of road stood at 63%. In international comparison, Switzerland's rail share is high: the average of all EU states is around 19%.
