Structural Survey

Description

Since 2010, the Structural Survey has been conducted within the framework of the new population census. The main focus of this survey is to observe the socio-economic and socio-cultural structures of the population in Switzerland.

Available since:

2010

Statistical basis:

Persons aged 15 or more in the permanent resident population living in private households

Key variables:

Language, religion, education, work, commuter mobility, types of households and families, dwelling occupation status and rent

Methodology

Sample survey of 200 000 persons with online questionnaire (eCensus) or paper questionnaire

Degree of regionalisation:

Canton

Periodicity: Annual

Reference period:

Reference day: 31 December

Scanning the paper questionnaires:

The scanning mandate was awarded to the firm Tessi document solutions (Switzerland) GmbH by means of a WTO call for tender. Awarding of the contract was published on 7 May 2018 at www.simap.ch.

Policy on revisions

Regular revision (or continuous revision):

Regular adjustments made to questionnaire every five years (next questionnaire revision: 2025).

Methodology revision: (or fundamental revision):

In 2018, fundamental revision of the survey procedure, the weighting methodology and the method used to detect outliers.

Earlier data are currently not recalculated using the new methodological changes.
