Supplementary accommodation statistics (PASTA)

Description

The supplementary accommodation statistics (PASTA) are conducted at national level among a sample of commercially-run holiday homes and collective accommodation. Their goal is to collect data on supply and demand in this type of accommodation.

Available since:

Characteristics recorded:

The key variables are: Number of commercially-run holiday homes or collective accommodation units and number of beds as well as number of arrivals and overnight stays per month, by visitors' country of residence.

Statistical population:

PASTA register (PASTAREG) whose sources are the communes, the tourism offices and booking platforms.

Survey unit:

The statistical unit is the commercially-run holiday home or collective accommodation (unit).

Methodology

The PASTA statistics are based on a sample survey. Data are collected on a quarterly basis by means of a paper questionnaire or online (http://www.esurvey.bfs.admin.ch/epasta). Participation in the survey is compulsory, with the exception of natural persons in private households, for whom participation is optional.
