



# Legislature Indicators

## Description

The legislature indicators are used to monitor the Federal Council's objectives. They are taken from the indicator system for the Federal Council and Parliament that encompasses all areas of federal tasks. The system was created by the Federal Statistical Office at the request of the Federal Chancellery and in close cooperation with the relevant departments and federal offices.

The legislature indicators and the indicator system for the Federal Council and Parliament are revised every four years at the start of the legislature plan.
