



Swiss Standard Classification of Occupations – CH-ISCO-19

Description

The Swiss Standard Classification of Occupations CH-ISCO-19 incorporates the first four levels of the International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO-08) and has added a fifth level to take into account the particularities of the Swiss labour market. This classification replaces the Swiss Standard Classification of Occupations from 2000 (SSCO 2000).

Current version:

Methodology

Five-tiered classification code structure Major group (one digit), Sub-major group (two digits), Minor group (three digits), Unit group (four digits) and Type (five digits).

Policy on revisions

Routine revisions:

Possible adaptations of the 5th level (types of occupation) every 3 years (1st time Octobre 2022) to meet national needs.

Methodology revisions:

According to the periodic revisions of the International Standard Classification of Occupations ISCO (ISCO)
