Swiss Consumer Price Index in June 2025

Consumer prices increased by 0.2% in June

The consumer price index (CPI) increased by 0.2% in June 2025 compared with the previous month, reaching 107.8 points (December 2020 = 100). Inflation was +0.1% compared with the same month of the previous year. These are the results of the Federal Statistical Office (FSO).

The 0.2% increase compared with the previous month is due to several factors including rising prices for international package holidays, hotels and supplementary accommodation. The hire of private means of transport and various vegetables also recorded a price increase. In contrast, prices for petrol, air transport and stone fruits decreased.

Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP)

In June 2025, the Swiss Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP) stood at 107.66 points (base 2015 = 100). This corresponds to a rate of change of +0.2% compared with the previous month and of +0.2% compared with the same month the previous year.

The HICP is a supplementary indicator for inflation based on a harmonised method across EU member countries. It enables inflation in Switzerland to be compared with that of European countries.

The European Statistical Office, Eurostat, publishes the results according to a predefined calendar. The FSO publishes a comparison between inflation in Switzerland and Europe on the webpage www.hicp.bfs.admin.ch. A methodological note and the 2025 weighting of the Swiss standard HICP basket are also available on this page.

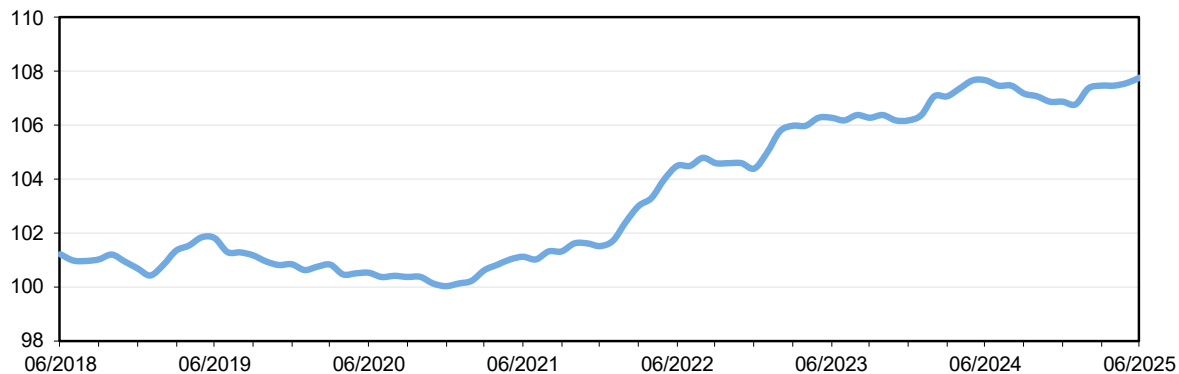

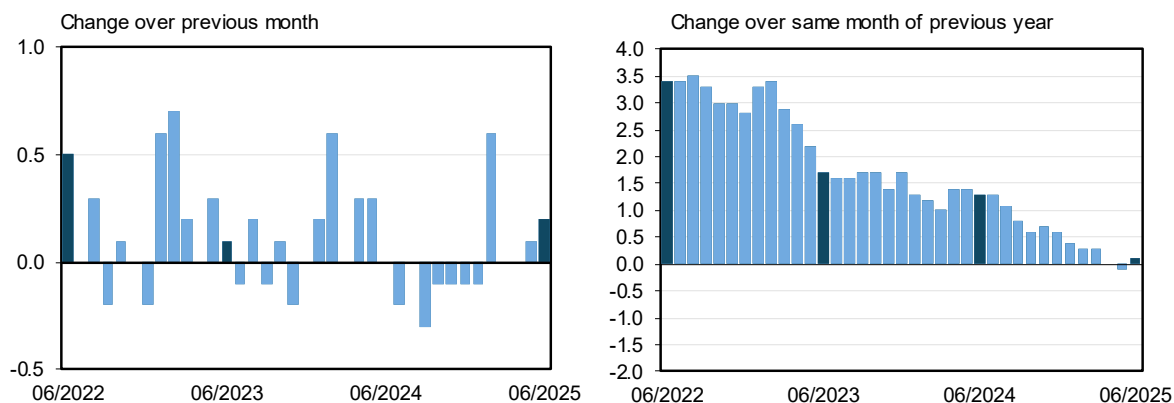
