## Dwelling vacancy rate falls to 1 per cent in 2025

On 1 June 2025, there were 48 455 vacant dwellings in Switzerland. This was 1% of the total dwelling stock (including single-family houses). There were thus 3519 fewer vacant dwellings compared with the previous year, a decrease of 6.8%. This is the fifth consecutive decline in the vacancy rate. These are the latest results from the Federal Statistical Office's (FSO) Empty Dwellings Census.
