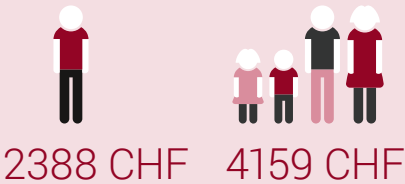


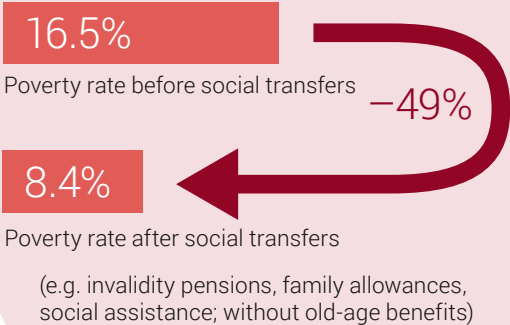
Persons affected by income poverty

Poverty line (per month)



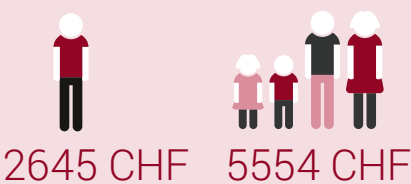
Decrease in the poverty rate through social transfers
